RECOGNIZING JULY 3, 2012 AS
"CARY TOWN BAND DAY" IN THE TOWN OF CARY

WHEREAS, the Cary Town Band was founded in 1987 by Dr. James R. Hammerle to afford citizens the opportunity to share their talents with the Cary community.

WHEREAS, this concert marks the beginning of a season celebrating this milestone in the Band's and the Town's history.

WHEREAS, the Cary Town Band is one of the charter resident organizations at the Cary Arts Center and continues to provide free outdoor and indoor concerts each year for civic and patriotic events, including Lazy Daze and the Fourth of July celebration at Koka Booth Amphitheatre.


